



## LOCKERS AND BENCH SEATING – operation and maintenance



### **Maintenance and Cleaning Recommendations**

- These items should only be cleaned with dry dusters and proprietary household polishes.
- For steel lockers, contact with water should be minimised as the lockers are manufactured in mild steel and corrosion eventually may occur. For solid grade laminate lockers, water may be used for cleaning as required as the laminate and aluminium construction are suited to wet environments.
- Avoid using industrial floor washing equipment near the base of steel lockers as there is a likelihood of water being displaced underneath the base of the lockers.
- Floor polishing machines should not make contact with base of steel lockers as this will lead to deterioration of the paint finish – laminate lockers are much more hard wearing and will withstand polishing machines.
- Timber on the seats should only be dusted and polished, and in time may require re-varnishing.
