

Pickleball post and net system



Details

Fast becoming one of the most popular racket sports in the world, [pickleball](#) brings together some of the best elements of tennis, badminton and table tennis, into a fun and exciting game for people of all ages and abilities.

Many pickleball systems are "toy" systems made from collapsible thin metal frames that fold into a bag, designed as "pop-up" nets for occasional use. Such systems are great fun but not suitable for the rigours of institutional or commercial use.

Continental has therefore developed a pickleball system designed to be as robust and durable as all our sports gamesposts and goals. Ideal for sports centres, schools, indoor tennis centres and similar facilities

The interlocking box section steel base sections that span between the posts mean the posts are freestanding and sufficiently robust to enable the net to be tensioned correctly to obtain regulation net height. The posts can be used without the interlocking base section if they are secured to your floor with floor anchors. Please contact us to discuss the requirements and cost for Continental to install floor anchors in your facility.

The system comprises:

- Two freestanding posts with non-marking rubber feet and integral wheels
- Three interlocking sections with non-marking rubber feet to hold the posts together the correct distance apart
- One bespoke pickleball net with easy to attach PVC sleeves
- Non-stretch Kevlar net headline to enable suitable tension to be achieved
- Two clam cleats to enable simple tensioning of the net to achieve regulation 36" (0.91m) at the posts and at least 34" (0.86m) in the centre

The posts are epoxy powder coated in red as standard. The net has a regulation white 2" (50mm) top band

Continental's pickleball system is designed for indoor use in sports halls and indoor tennis centres. The steelwork is powder coated but not galvanised so the system may be used outside but not stored outside and subject to rain.
