## **VOLLEYBALL "INTERNATIONAL" POSTS**



When reading the instructions below, please refer to the drawing on the next page

- 1. The International volleyball post arrangement consists of one post with tension ratchet A and one post without B.
- 2. Position the posts over the floor anchors, place the thumbscrews **C** through the holes in the base and tighten the thumbscrews into the anchors until the bases of the posts are held firmly against the floor
- 3. Select a net height (men's, women's or mini), un-tighten the black and red thumbscrew **D** and slide the net slider up or down until the metal indictor reads off the correct height, then re-tighten the thumbscrew.
- 4. Attach the net headline on the non-ratchet post to the top metal locating point E
- 5. On the ratchet post pass the headline of the net behind the pulley at the top  $\mathbf{F}$  and attach it to the hook in the ratchet mechanism  $\mathbf{G}$ .
- 6. Tighten the ratchet mechanism ensuring the locking arm **H** is located in the ratchet teeth to ensure the ratchet operates correctly.
- When the net is taught, use the telescopic net measuring device I located on the side of the non-ratchet post to confirm the exact height. Undertake any necessary adjustment or leveling using the micro-adjusters on each post J
- Tie-off the side net ties on the other metal locating points on the sliders in each post K
- 9. Regularly check all items for wear. If replacements are necessary, contact Continental.
